HISTORY & MISSION

The Empire Ranch, established in 1876, was one of the largest cattle ranches in southern Arizona, and the location for more than 30 classic films and television series including Gunsmoke, Red River and Oklahoma! It has survived droughts, wildfires, and land developers, and still stands strong.

For 150 years the historic Empire Ranch has hosted hard-working ranchers, visitors seeking peaceful landscapes, notable movie crews, and families discovering the Old West. Now more than ever, the irreplaceable heritage of the Empire Ranch provides a source of hope, inspiration, determination, and preservation.

The Empire Ranch Foundation was established as a 501(c)(3) nonprofit in 1997 to "Protect, restore and sustain the Empire Ranch historical buildings and landscape as an outstanding western heritage and education center." WHY SPONSOR THE ERF
